## What does the WSD do?



Students who come to the WSD are asked to talk and explain about their papers. In this process, students recognize problematic points in their papers. Therefore, by explaining the paper to someone, students are encouraged to "**identify**" and "**resolve**" these issues on their own. Students are welcome to talk about their papers at any stage of the writing process. Even if the students have not written any single word in their paper, the WSD tutors will serve as a venue for dialogue and discussions on matters related to the writing process. This may include brainstorming process to help students understand and identify a potential topic to work on. WSD help with both Japanese and English paper. Both languages are available in the session, too.

The WSD has prepared a rich collection of documents useful for academic writing. While introducing these documents to students, tutors support students to be able to correct their own papers. The WSD's objective is to encourage your growth as an academic writer.
